League Study on Fracking Completed

Our discussion on fracking on November 19 provided us with background information as presented by Rona Ackerman of the Fairfax League. March 11 we met to discuss questions that resulted in our consensus on a LWV-VA position to use for advocacy. We submitted our report to the LWV-VA Board so that it could be included in reports from the other eleven local Leagues in Virginia. The LWV-VA Board met in April and approved a position on fracking that will be submitted for approval to the Delegates to the Convention June 10 and 11.

Will the position say that we should support a moratorium on fracking?
