Voting Information

Polls are open from 6 a.m. – 7 p.m. for all elections

Check your voter registration card for your correct voting site. All voters will be asked to provide photo identification at the polls. Contact your General Registrar for appropriate forms of identification.

You are eligible to register to vote if you are:

- A citizen of the United States
- A resident of Virginia; and
- At least 18 years of age or will be by the next general election

Voter Registration

You may pick up a Voter Registration Application from any public library and Department of Motor Vehicles Office. For other locations, contact your General Registrar. You can also download and print the Voter Registration Application Form from the State Board of Elections website, www.sbe.virginia.gov/cms/ or the website of your General Registrar.

Online: One can now register to vote, view and update your voter record online both at the Virginia Department of Elections www.elections.virginia.gov and the DMV <https://www.dmv.virginia.gov/general/#vote.asp>.

Absentee Voting - New for November 2020

Any registered voter may vote by absentee ballot.

By Mail: Application forms may be requested from one of the General Registrar Offices as listed below or downloaded from the jurisdiction's website. Mailed/faxed applications must be received in the General Registrar's office by 5 P.M. eleven (11) days prior to the election day.

In Person: Voting will be available 45 days and up to and including the last Saturday prior to each election or as soon as ballots are received.

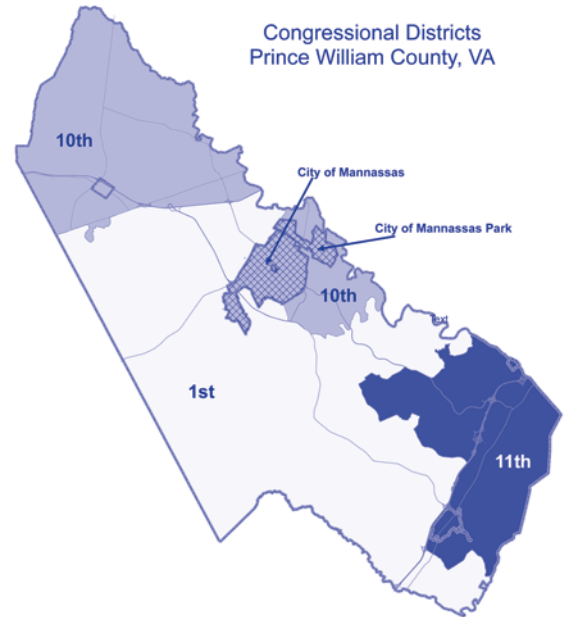

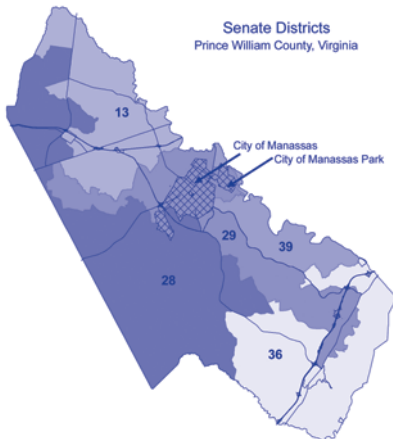

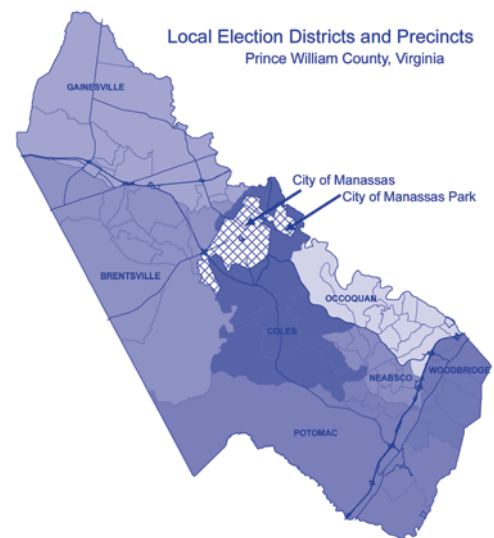
