## **What YOU Need to Know About Virginia's Redistricting Election**

**Saturday, March 21, 2026**

**1:00 – 3:00 pm**

Redistricting normally takes place every 10 years, following the U.S. Census. This year, the Virginia Legislature has proposed a mid-decade reshaping of election districts, rather than wait until 2030. On April 21, voters will decide whether to support this change. The League of Women Voters has invited an expert to explain the demographics and voting history of our counties, revealing how and why this area has become a focus of the state's new plan.
